Award Guidelines

- Certified membership with CSMLS in good standing (current)
- Have been employed in an Medical Laboratory Technologist or Medical Laboratory Assistant related profession for 2-5 years
- Demonstrated commitment to continuous learning for personal and professional development
- Provide evidence of leadership ability (professional advancement, leadership in the workplace, volunteer achievements, awards, etc.)
- Canadian citizenship or permanent resident status
- A member may only be awarded one grant, scholarship or award per year with the exception of the BD Quality Assurance Project Award (if available)
- Current members of the CSMLS Board of Directors, staff and their immediate families are not eligible for this award.

Other Information

- Incomplete applications will not be accepted
- Winners must submit a final report (1-2 pages) to CSMLS and provide permission to publicly display it on the CSMLS website and other CSMLS media outlets as required. May also be requested to create a poster for LABCON.

Judging Criteria

Scholarship applications will be reviewed by the CSMLS Grants, Scholarships & Awards Committee. Each submission will be awarded points according to the following formula, to a maximum score of 100.

- Written Expression of Interest (25 points)
- Personal & Professional Accomplishments (25 points)
- Leadership & Volunteer Service (25 points)
- Professional development activities (25 points)
