Honorary Awards

These awards are sponsored by the Canadian Society for Medical Laboratory Science and are intended to recognize and acknowledge individuals for outstanding achievements and/or for their contributions to the profession of medical laboratory science or to the CSMLS.

Honorary Membership

Honorary Membership is awarded in recognition of a member's outstanding contribution to the Canadian Society for Medical Laboratory Science.

Guidelines

- 1. The nominee must be a certified member (practicing, non-practicing, or retired)
- 2. Three nominators are required. Nominations may be submitted by a member at large and each nomination must be accompanied by a citation outlining the nominee's contributions to society activity at all levels.
- A member may only be awarded one grant, scholarship or award per year with the exception of the BD Quality Assurance Project Award (if available).

- Nominations must be submitted (postmarked) not later than November 1st of each year.
- 5. Current members of the CSMLS Board of Directors, staff or their immediate families are not eligible.
- Nominations that are declined by the Grants, Scholarships & Awards Committee cannot be resubmitted for a period of three years.
- Approved nominees will receive all the privileges and services of membership without payment of membership fees. A memento to commemorate the award will be presented at LABCON and the expenses of the recipient are paid to receive the award in person.

Honorary Affiliate Membership

Honorary Affiliate Membership is awarded to a non-member of the CSMLS who is involved in the health care field, in recognition of services to the CSMLS in advancing the aims and objectives of the Society.

Guidelines

- Three nominators are required. Nominations may be submitted by members at large and each nomination must be accompanied by a citation outlining the nominee's services to the CSMLS and to medical laboratory technology
- A member may only be awarded one grant, scholarship or award per year with the exception of the BD Quality Assurance Project Award (if available).
- Nominations must be submitted (postmarked) not later than November 1st of each year.

- 4. Nominations that are declined by the Grants, Scholarships & Awards Committee cannot be resubmitted for a period of three years
- 5. Current members of the CSMLS Board of Directors, staff and their immediate families are not eligible.
- 6. The recipient receives all the privileges and services accorded to CSMLS members, except the right to vote and hold elected office. A memento to commemorate the award is presented at LABCON and the expenses of the recipient are paid to receive the award in person.
