The Board of Directors of the Canadian Society for Medical Laboratory Science is offering grants to students, new graduates and medical laboratory assistants to attend LABCON2024 in St. John's Newfoundland - June 21st – 23rd 2024.

Award Guidelines

The grants consist of the following:

- Free registration for LABCON
- Up to \$2,000 to cover travel/accommodation costs
- No cash value

Up to six grants are available to be awarded to:

- New medical laboratory technology graduates
- Medical laboratory students (MLA or MLT)
- CSMLS certified medical laboratory assistants

Current members of the CSMLS Board of Directors, staff and their immediate families are not eligible for this award.

A member may only be awarded one monetary grant, scholarship or award per year with the exception of the BD Quality Assurance Project Award (if available)

Award Eligibility Requirements

• Current CSMLS Membership

Medical Laboratory Technologists - New Graduates

• Have achieved CSMLS certification within the last five years

Medical Laboratory Students

- Be enrolled in the final or clinical year of a full-time accredited medical laboratory education program (MLA or MLT) OR
- Be enrolled in a full-time or part-time Canadian Bridging program at the time of applying

Medical Laboratory Assistants

• Be certified as a medical laboratory assistant by the CSMLS

Previous winners of the LABCON Grant are not eligible. The deadline for submission is November 1st. Please note you will be contacted regarding your status via email
