Honorary Fellowship of the CSMLS – FCSMLS (Hon)

Honorary Fellowship of the CSMLS is granted to former practising medical laboratory professionals who have gone on to distinguished careers in other professions, not limited to careers in science or medicine.

Nominees for Honorary Fellowship must have been certified members of the CSMLS at some point in their career.

Criteria:

- 1. Nominations for Honorary Fellowship require three nominators or proposers. Two of the proposers must be members of CSMLS.
- 2. The nomination must be accompanied by a fully detailed résumé of the nominee's career, including an outline of all certificates, diplomas and degrees obtained, professional and scientific achievements, contributions to medical laboratory science, awards received and a list of published works (papers, books, articles, online content/presentations etc.) that contribute to the promotion of awareness of laboratory science.
- The President, in consultation with the Executive Staff, may appoint assessors who are knowledgeable in the main area of the nominee's field of profession activity to review published work of the nominee and report to the Grants, Scholarships & Awards Committee on the value of that work.
- The Grants, Scholarships & Awards
 Committee shall review the nominee's
 career resumé and evaluate the level of
 professional expertise and achievement.

- 5. On the basis of the review of the nominee's career and the reports from the external assessors, the Grants, Scholarships & Awards Committee may either:
 - a) recommend to the Board of Directors that Fellowship be granted;
 - b) decline the nomination as not meeting the level of professional achievement required.
- 6. Presentation of the memento conferring Fellowship takes place at the next LABCON and the recipient's expenses for attendance will be paid by the CSMLS. Recipient also receives free CSMLS membership for life and the use of the FCSMLS(Hon) designation.
- Nominations that are declined by the Grants, Scholarships & Awards Committee cannot be resubmitted for a period of three years.
- A member may only be awarded one grant, scholarship or award per year with the exception of the BD Quality Assurance Project Award (if available).
- Members of the CSMLS Board of Directors, staff and their families are not eligible for Fellowship Awards.

The deadline for submission is November 1st.

Educational/Professional

- outline the diplomas/degrees attained including educational institutions and dates
- outline professional qualifications or designations achieved including dates

Employment

for the previous ten years including employer's name, address, dates, and positions held

Publications

• list all publications that the nominee has authored, co-authored or contributed to, relevant to their career and/or the medical laboratory profession. This may include journal submissions, book reviews and other written material.

Professional Involvement

• describe the contributions made to the CSMLS and the profession of medical laboratory science at the local, provincial and/or national level.



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Other Involvement

 describe the nominee's involvement and contributions made to other associations including other professional societies, community groups, service clubs, etc.

Citation

 describe, in a format suitable for publication, how the nominee meets the award criteria as outlined on the fact sheet. (Recommended length: 600 words)
